CITY AND DATE OF CHAMPIONSHIP:

The Championship will be held in Riccione, Italy, March 1-2, 2003

SPORTCENTRE AND ADDRESS:

The event will take place in the Sport centre "Pattinodromo"

DIVISION / CATEGORIES:

Divisions/categories must consist of two or more competitors – if there is only one competitor he/she will compete in a lower or higher category or division.

Black Belts M/F

adults 16 years and older

Coloured Belts M/F

adults 16 years and older

Pattern divisions Male/Female:

Black Belts divided into: 1st degree, 2nd degree and 3rd + 4th degree (one group)

Pattern eliminations and finals- one (1) optional Pattern

Coloured belts divided into: yellow/green belts and blue/red belts

Pattern eliminations and finals - one (1) optional Pattern

Sparring divisions – weight categories male / female:

yellow-green belts

male

-65 kg, -75 kg, + 75 kg

sparring eliminations and finals – one (1) round of 2 minutes

blue/red belts

male

-65 kg, -75 kg, + 75 kg

sparring eliminations and finals – one (1) round of 2 minutes

female

-55 kg, + 55 kg

black belts

male

-54 kg, -63 kg, -71 kg, -80 kg, + 80 kg

female

-52 kg, -58 kg, -63 kg, -70kg, +70kg

sparring eliminations and finals – one (1) round of 3 minutes

Competitors entrance fee (to be paid in euro):

black Belts and or coloured Belts = EURO 25,00

MEDAL AWARDINGS for 1,2 AND 2 x 3 PLACE

INSURANCE:

all competitors must have full insurance coverage for eventualities

ARRIVALS:

arrivals on Friday March 1st ,2003 (or before).

proceed to the meeting point in the Sport Centre “Pattinodromo” in via Carpi, Riccione from 17.00 hrs to 23.00 hrs for inscription and payments of competitors entrance fee and hotel accommodation.

HOTELS:

hotel accommodation (minimum 2 nights) including full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner) at EURO 45,00 per person per day sharing a double or triple room. single room add EURO 8,00 person per day.

hotel accommodation must be paid on arrival at the meeting point.

COACHES:

coaches must wear a training suit and gymnastic shoes and must accept any result given by the umpires as protest will not be accepted.

they should bring with them two national country flags

UMPIRES:

umpires must wear blue long trousers and white gymnastic shoes.

the organization/sponsor will provide a polo shirt.

the organization will pay a 3 days (2 nights) accommodation including full board for one (1) umpire per country or groups.

HOW TO GET TO RICCIONE:

by car or bus: take the autostrada (highway) from Milan or Venice to bologna and then to Ancona (a14). follow the exit “Riccione” and proceed to the Sport Centre “Pattinodromo” - via Carpi, Riccione.

by train: on arrival at the railway station call a taxi a proceed to the Sport Centre “Pattinodromo”.

by plane: on arrival at Rimini airport call Master Bos at number : 338-7874552
